#### **SAFEGUARDING EVENT: JULY 1 ST**

This is an opportunity for all those in our parish who have Ministries with Children and / or Vulnerable Adults, including those who facilitate the Children's Liturgy and Special Ministers of the Eucharist, to meet and discuss the potential Safeguarding issues that they may come across whilst undertaking their roles. We hope for a good turnout.

Bishop's Certificate in Catechesis: There are two BCC courses starting this autumn, in Mansfield and in Shepshed. #### Gift Aid and Income Tax:

This is an important message to all those who give money to the Church and have made a Gift Aid Declaration (or pre-2000 have made a deed of covenant in favour of the Church). In order to be valid, your Gift Aided donation to the Church, when added to all of the other donations you make under a Gift Aid Declaration, must not exceed the part of your income subject to tax. Now that the first £10,000 of your income is not subject to tax you *may* need to advise Ann Gee in our diocesan Gift Aid Office (a: Gift Aid Office, Willson House, 25 Derby Road, NOTTINGHAM NG1 5AW; e: giftaid@nrcdt.org.uk; t: 0115 953 9843) or via Margot Madin, our parish Gift Aid organiser that your donations are no longer to be made under Gift Aid.

#### **New sets of Box Envelopes for Parish Givings**

First of all I like to thank all the parishioners their generosity to the parish upkeep over the past year. Your giving and support are very important to the parish, in order for the parish to maintain its fabrics and providing a safe and comfortable environment in our celebration and gathering socially after Mass in the Parish Hall. Those who are giving via envelopes and those who give using the Standing Order via the Bank, are the source of the parish main income. If you are a tax payer, please consider to sign a Gift Aid Declaration Form so that the parish can claim an extra 28pence per pounds from the Inland Revenue without you having to give a penny more. Last year the Parish raised an extra £3556.00 from Tax Repayment. Our parish other main income last year came from Hall Hire which generated just under £7,000.00 which is a tremendous sum of money. The Parish would not be viable financially without this sum of money. However, the current trend is that the Hall bookings is down compared with previous years, and our expected income from the Hall hire will be down as well. This is worrying because we rely quite heavily on the income from the Hall. May I ask parishioner to consider increase their giving, especially those who have not done so for a few years.

#### **Lay Catholic Chaplain to HMP Sudbury**

We are currently seeking to recruit a Lay Catholic Chaplain on a ten hours per week sessional contract.
