Minutes of previous meeting: The minutes of 12th June were approved and signed.

1. Pastoral & Liturgy:

- a) The PAG trip to Chester was a success, and a coach trip to York is booked for 13th September.
- b) Geoff Dennis asked if Rev. Wootton could speak on salvation during Advent. Fr. Ka Fai suggested one session in the Meeting Room.
- c) The Children are planning a Harvest Festival Mass for Sunday 12th October with all food donations going to Derby Food Bank and money going to CAFOD.
- 2. <u>Website</u>: Liam Leavesley is maintaining the website. There are still dated items in news e.g. Lent, and there is a need to supply Liam with fresh material to keep it relevant. Contributions please!

3. Buildings:

a) Maintenance

- i) The annual buildings walk-round is due. Terry McMenamin, Joe Rudski, Tony Heron & Steve Hempsall will participate.
- ii) Organ repaired but PAT re-test is needed. Leave till next annual check?
- iii) Church windows Jim McGuinn has repaired the Derby side beadings. Unfortunately some sills are rotten, another project looms! Lisa, Tony Heron & Steve Hempsall will varnish the windows.
- iv) Toilet maintenance all now working.
- v) Hedges the hedges need very heavy pruning away from the buildings and from the narrow roadway at the Derby gable end of the Hall.
- vi) Field Lisa will try and arrange a horse or horses to graze it. Geoff observed that we must avoid any responsibility for animals escaping.

b) Projects

- i) Roof three contractors have been contacted, two have already examined the roof and one has quoted. The roofers show no desire to quote for minimum repair, citing the cost, risks of damage and doubtful gain. Terry will keep the Diocesan Building & Sites team informed to hopefully gain project approval at their meeting on 10th September.
- ii) Toilet refurbishment two quotations have been requested. The idea of a unisex layout was not supported. Views on the project differ, but it can be considered by the parish after the roof.
- iii) Church side porch and former sacristy Ian and Mary Chater volunteered to lay carpet tiles.
- iv) Hedges the hedges need very heavy pruning away from the buildings and from the narrow roadway at the Derby gable end of the Hall.
- c) The aerial survey of the field is overdue.
